Clare's Law

If you are worried about your relationship, or someone else's, you can request information from the police whether the person of concern has a history of domestic abuse.

Clare's Law is design to protect potential victims from abuse.

The scheme works in two ways:

- A right to ask: This is where information is disclosed following a request from a member of the public.
- A right to know: This is where the police make a decision to disclose information to a potential victim when they receive information to suggest a person could be at risk.
